Corporate Membership

Definition: Corporate memberships invite community-conscious organizations to participate in giving back to the community through the well-organized systems and structures of Rotary. The Delta-Waverly Rotary Club provides a medium to learn about community needs in a variety of areas, and learn about and participate in fundraising and volunteering in ways that truly impact the community.

The Delta-Waverly Rotary Club now offers a special membership program that allows the organization one (1) corporate membership and one (1) affiliated active membership.

Corporate membership is available only to the President, Chief Executive Officer, Executive Director, or equivalent position. The Corporate Member would not have attendance or other participation requirements.

The Affiliated Active Member should be a senior officer, manager, or equivalent of the organization and would have the same attendance and participation requirements as a Sustaining Member of the Club.

A corporate membership allows for community-conscious organizations the opportunity to maintain membership year after year – even if the individuals filling the Corporate and Affiliated Active Member positions were to change. The corporate membership always stays with the club.

Dues: A Corporate Member pays dues of \$750 a year. This covers Rotary International and District dues, the monthly magazine, dues and lunch for the Affiliated Active Member, and Club operating costs. The Corporate Member would be responsible for the cost of lunch for any meetings he/she may attend – currently \$15 per lunch. In addition, the Corporate Member has the requirement of donating money or purchasing advertising in an amount that is at least \$500 to help underwrite club service projects.

The Affiliated Active Member will join the Club as a Sustaining Member with the dues included in the Corporate Member dues payment.

Considerations: Both the prospective organization and individuals must be of good character and reputation. Both the designated Corporate and Affiliated Active Member would receive all the privileges and opportunities of a Sustaining Member, including the right to attend club meetings, take part in service projects, and participate in fundraising activities. Only the Affiliated Active Member would be reported to Rotary International as an active member and be counted for attendance purposes.
